

St Patrick's College

The Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005 (Vic) (CWS Act) requires the College to investigate and report to the Commission for Children and Young People (CCYP) allegations of Reportable Conduct, or misconduct that may involve Reportable Conduct, against employees (reportable allegations).

Under the CWS Act, the "head of entity" for the College must notify the CCYP of a reportable allegation against an employee of which the "head" becomes aware. The "head of entity" for the College must also notify the CCYP of the outcomes of the College's internal investigation into the matter.

The "head of entity" for the College is the EREA VSL Chief Executive Officer.

This section of the Child Safety and Safeguarding Program sets out the College's expectations, systems, policies and procedures for enabling persons to report reportable conduct both internally and to the CCYP, and for such reports to be investigated and responded to by the College.
